

Transdev wins major contract for mobility services in Dallas (Texas, USA)

- **The contract is valued at US\$ 600 million**, for an operation term of more than eight years.
- **Start of service** will be October 1, 2024.
- **Paratransit** represents the largest share of the contract.
- **GoLink, North America's largest on-demand microtransit operation**, used by close to 900,000 riders a year, is integrated in this contract.

Issy-les-Moulineaux (France) - July 30, 2024 – Transdev has recently been awarded an eight-year and three month contract, valued at over US\$ 600 million, from the Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) agency in Texas (USA) for transportation programs, encompassing the operation of paratransit and microtransit services. Transdev will take over from the incumbent operator on October 1, 2024.

For instance, Transdev will ensure paratransit services for approximately 11,000 certified riders, as per the American with Disabilities Act (ADA¹), across the DART service area, encompassing 13 member cities and the Dallas Fort Worth International Airport. Transdev will also operate GoLink, North America's largest microtransit on-demand operation, covering 34 zones throughout the service area. In 2023, GoLink recorded a ridership of 886,000 passengers.

Thierry Mallet, Chairman and CEO of Transdev Group, explains: *"This new contract won in Texas testifies of our commitment to local authorities of bringing people and communities closer together. We do this all over the world with tailor-made mobility solutions that complement each other, by listening to our customers' needs and expectations, as was the case with DART. This new contract complements a raft of renewals in public transportation across the country, of which Las Vegas, Nassau County and Foothill Transit are the most notable"*.

Laura Hendricks, CEO of Transdev U.S., added, *"We are excited to partner with Dallas Area Rapid Transit and bring new technology and innovation to enhance the passenger experience. We are focused on a seamless transition in October where we hope to showcase our care and dedication to serving the community."*

The contract includes the provision of a new fleet of DART-branded vehicles, one single technology platform for all services, more onboard surveillance equipment for passenger safety, with the permanent objective of enhancing customer experience.
